Arrivavano con poche sterline in tasca, giovani senza un mestiere che magari non si erano mai allontanati prima dalla campagna e dovevano trovare subito un lavoro. Molti di loro si dirigevano alla stazione con un'etichetta applicata al cappotto, come fossero pacchi postali, sulla quale era scritto il nome del cantiere che li avrebbe ingaggiati. Le donne, più numerose degli uomini e in maggioranza single - un'anomalia nella storia dell'emigrazione europea - per lo più andavano a servizio nelle famiglie, oppure lavoravano come cameriere o infermiere.
