Some of these classes included a seasonally varying attribute (aquatic vegetation) as part of their definition, and the classes were not mutually exclusive. For example, a site in midchannel downstream of a dam might be classified as Main Channel (MC), Channel Trough (CTR), Open Tailwater (TWR-O), or Tailwater (TW). This classification scheme was revised in 1993 when vegetation status was dropped from the habitat designators and those categories that were viewed as redundant or not distinguishable by routine water quality measurements were eliminated.
